Form F2C. Terry Stop Questions

Was the client arrested before or after the police stopped and frisked her?

Was she arrested pursuant to a traffic stop?

If so, please refer to "Automobile Arrest Questions."

What did the police look like? How many were there? Does the client remember their names?

What specifically did the police find?

Did the police take anything with them? Did they give her or anyone else a receipt? Where is the receipt?

Was she or anyone else searched or frisked? If so, where?

Did the police have a search or arrest warrant?

Was she or anyone else arrested before or after the search?

Did the police ever threaten her in any way?

Did she or anyone else say anything to the police? If so, what admissions?

Form F2D. Automobile Arrest Questions

Who owns the car?

If the client did not own the car, had the owner given permission to the driver or passenger of the car to drive the car? Who had permission to drive the car?

When the client was arrested, was she inside the car? Outside the car? Where was the car?

If the client was inside the car at the time of arrest:

Was she the driver?

Was there anyone else in the car at the time? Who was sitting where? What was everyone doing?

Is she licensed to drive? Did the client have her driver's license at the time?

How did she react to the police? Did she try to elude the police? Did she try to hide or get rid of anything?

Was anything in the car? What? Where exactly was it in the car?

If she was not in the car when arrested:

Where was she arrested in relation to the car (*diagram*)?

Did she leave the car before or after the police arrived?

Did the police follow her to the car?

Did the police force open the car or any part of the car? Did they use keys? If they used keys, how did they get the keys?
